

Camp Glen Arden Policy Statement

Glen Arden is a community based on shared experiences and simple living. We do not have worldly music, world news, or worldly cares such as traffic, commercialism, or pollution of any kind. We work toward these ends in thought and deed. In order for us to achieve this, we ask for your cooperation.

Camp is a time to make new friends and meet people from new places. We assign campers to cabins with preference being given to those friendships formed at camp. No more than two friends from the same hometown will be placed together. We must receive in writing requests from both families in that regard three weeks prior to the beginning of the session. The assignments will be determined by the Camp Director, and decisions are final.

We ask that you review our No Package Policy. Campers are welcome to bring with them summer reading, a stuffed animal, a small toy or game. Cell phones, magazines, comic books, CD players, MP3 players, radios, computers, TVs, or electronic games should NOT be brought or sent to camp. They will be confiscated and kept in the camp safe until camp is over. Do NOT send any food items including gum to camp, any food items found will be taken from the camper.
